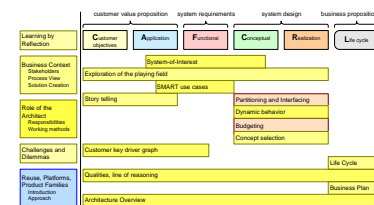
Abstract

This presentation explains the relevance of using reflection for learning.

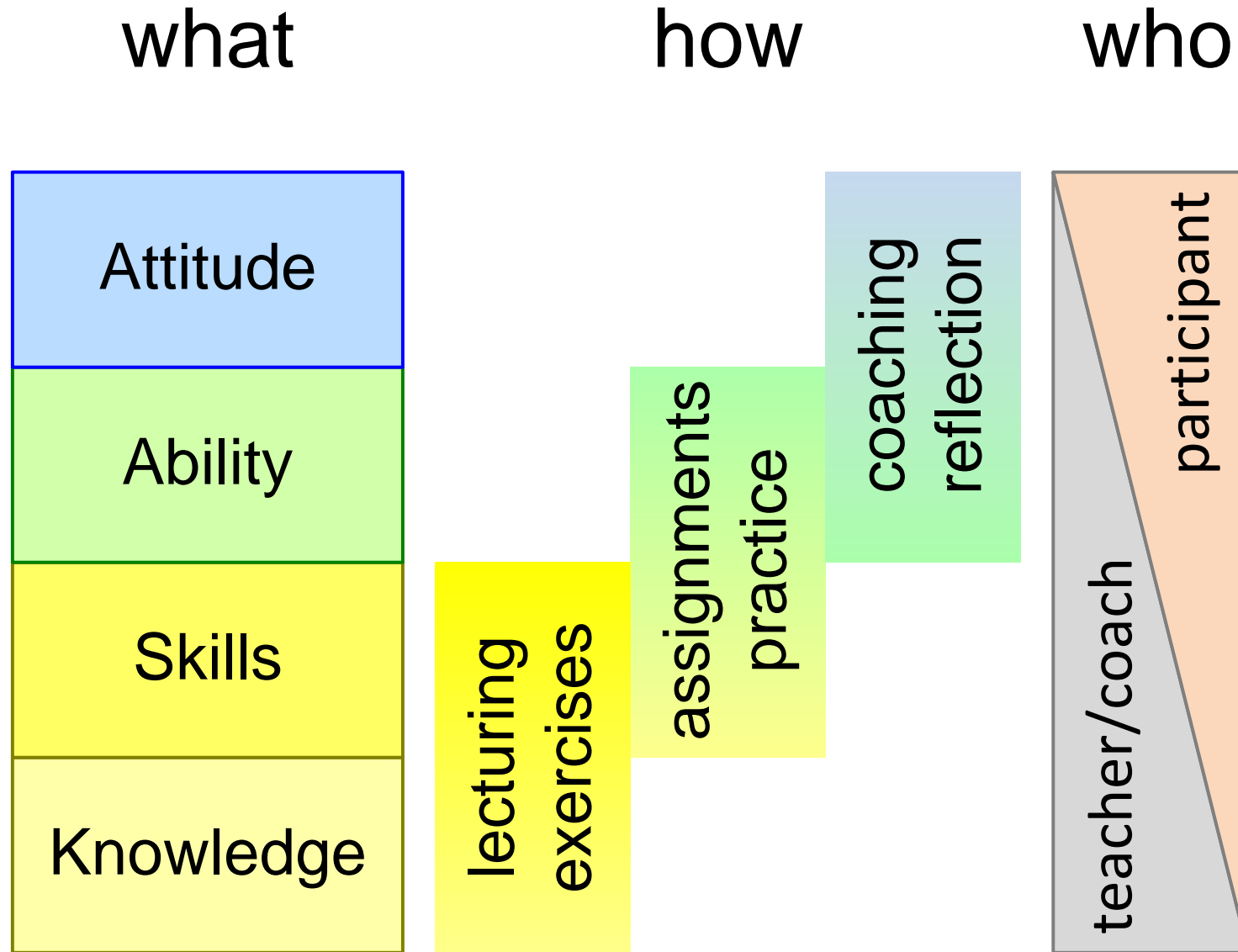
Distribution

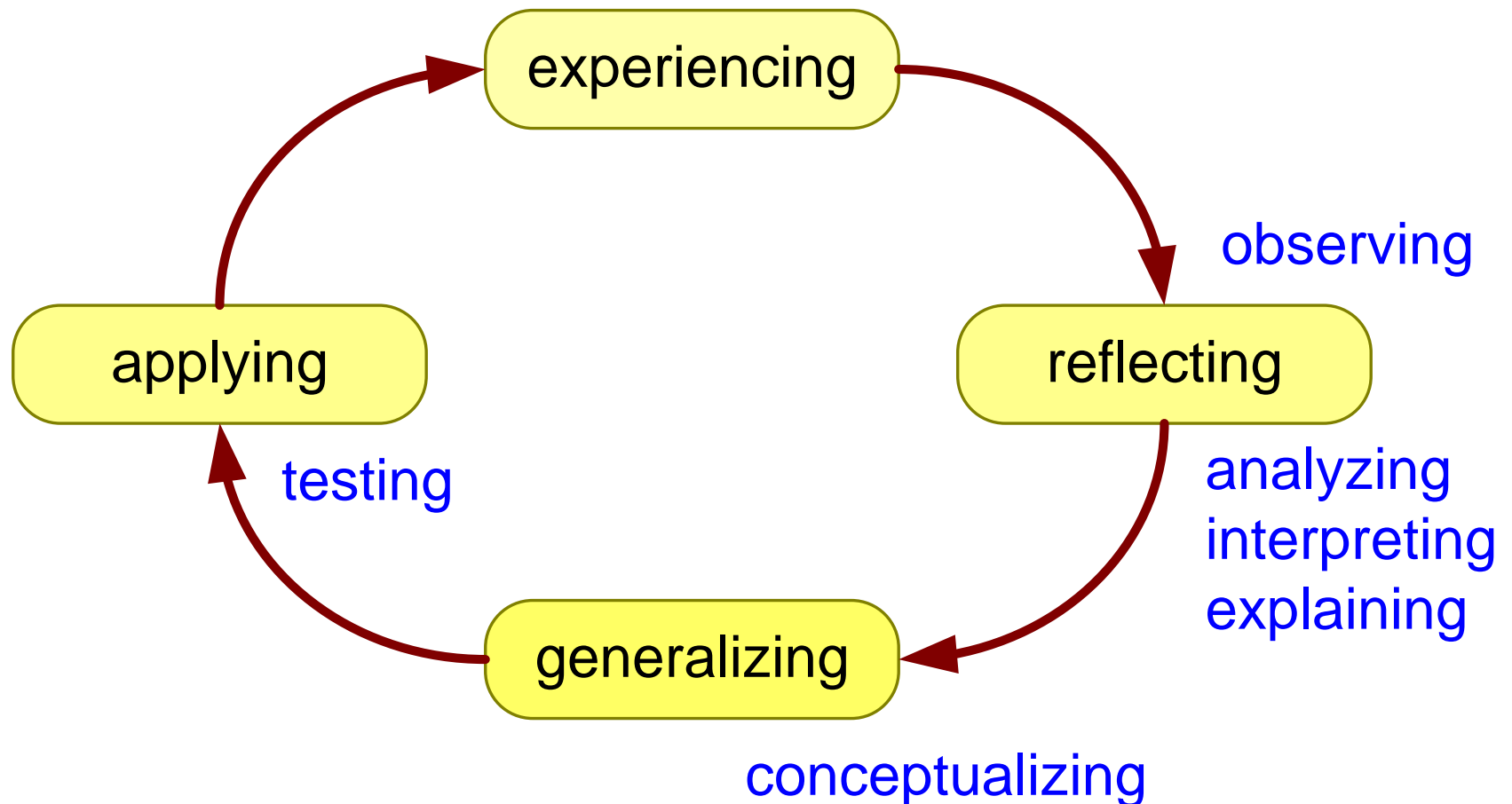

Competence Program Partitioning



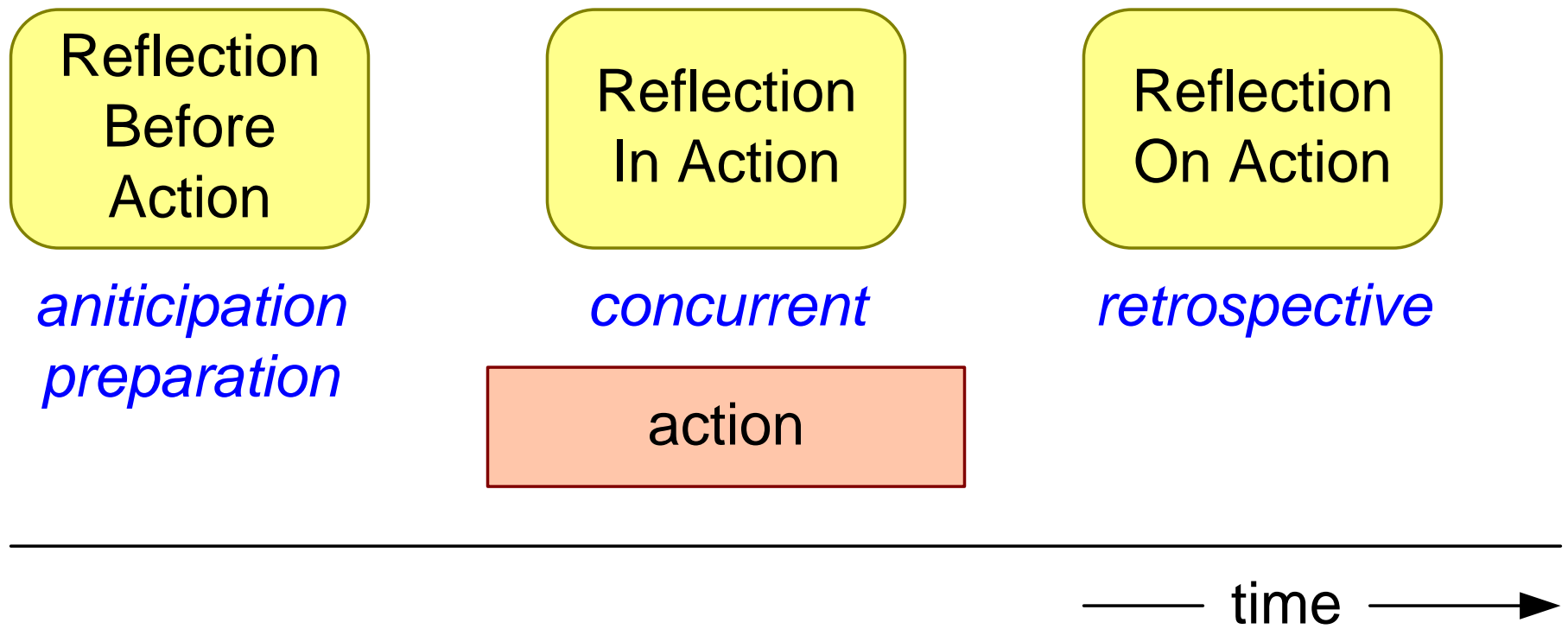
Reflection Cycle



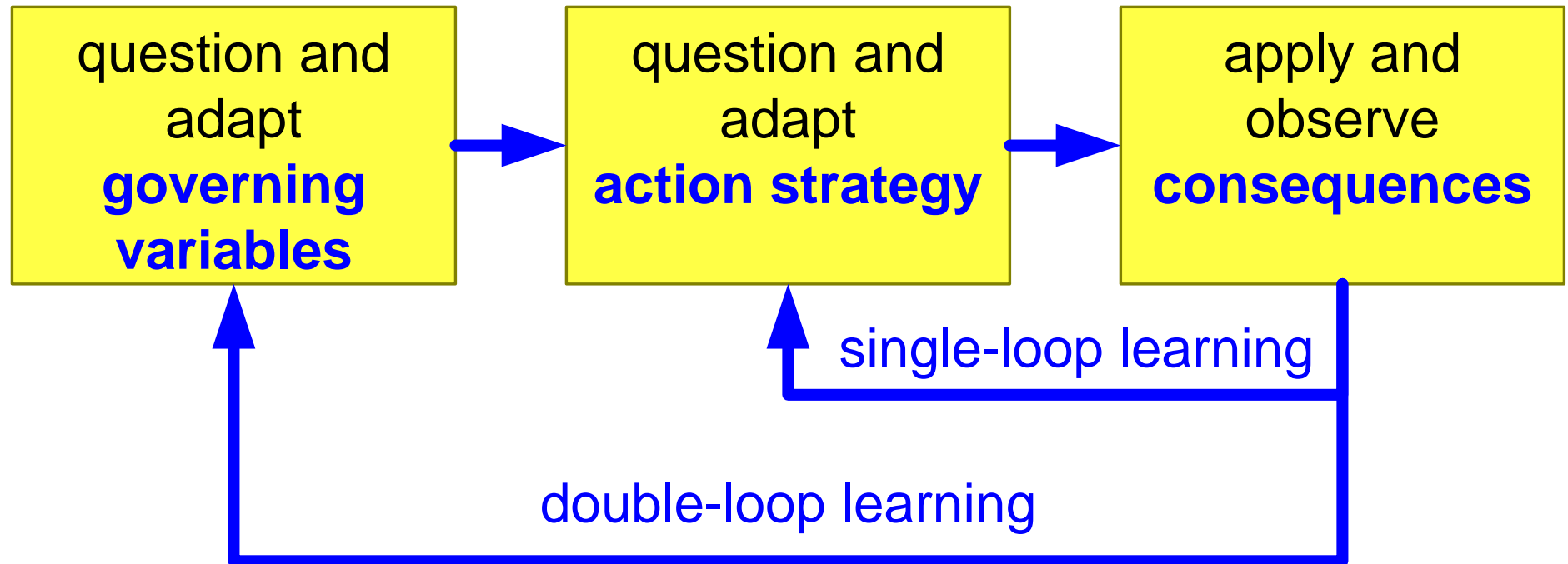
