This presentation discusses how to partition a documentation structure and how to make that accessible.

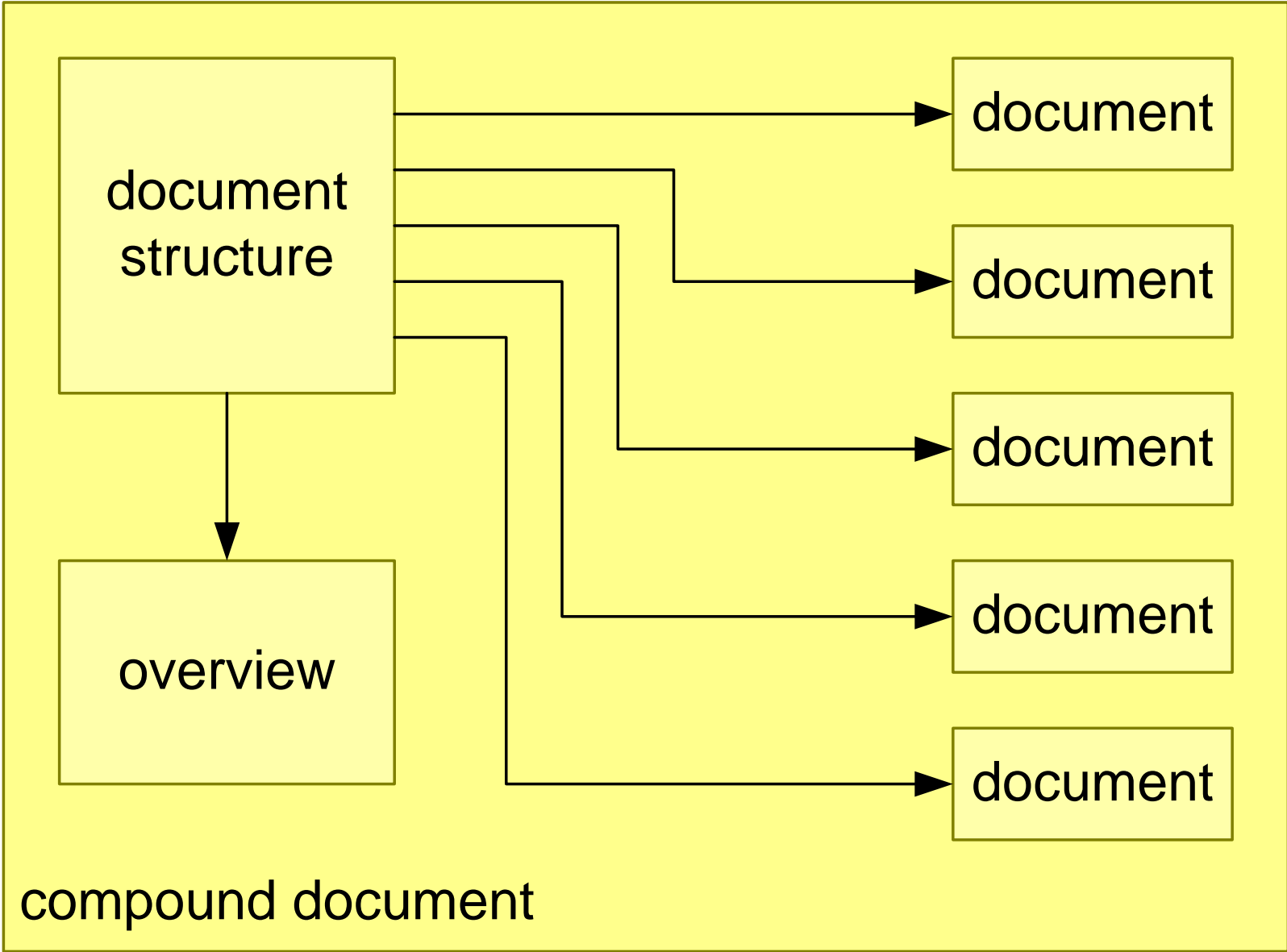
### **Distribution**

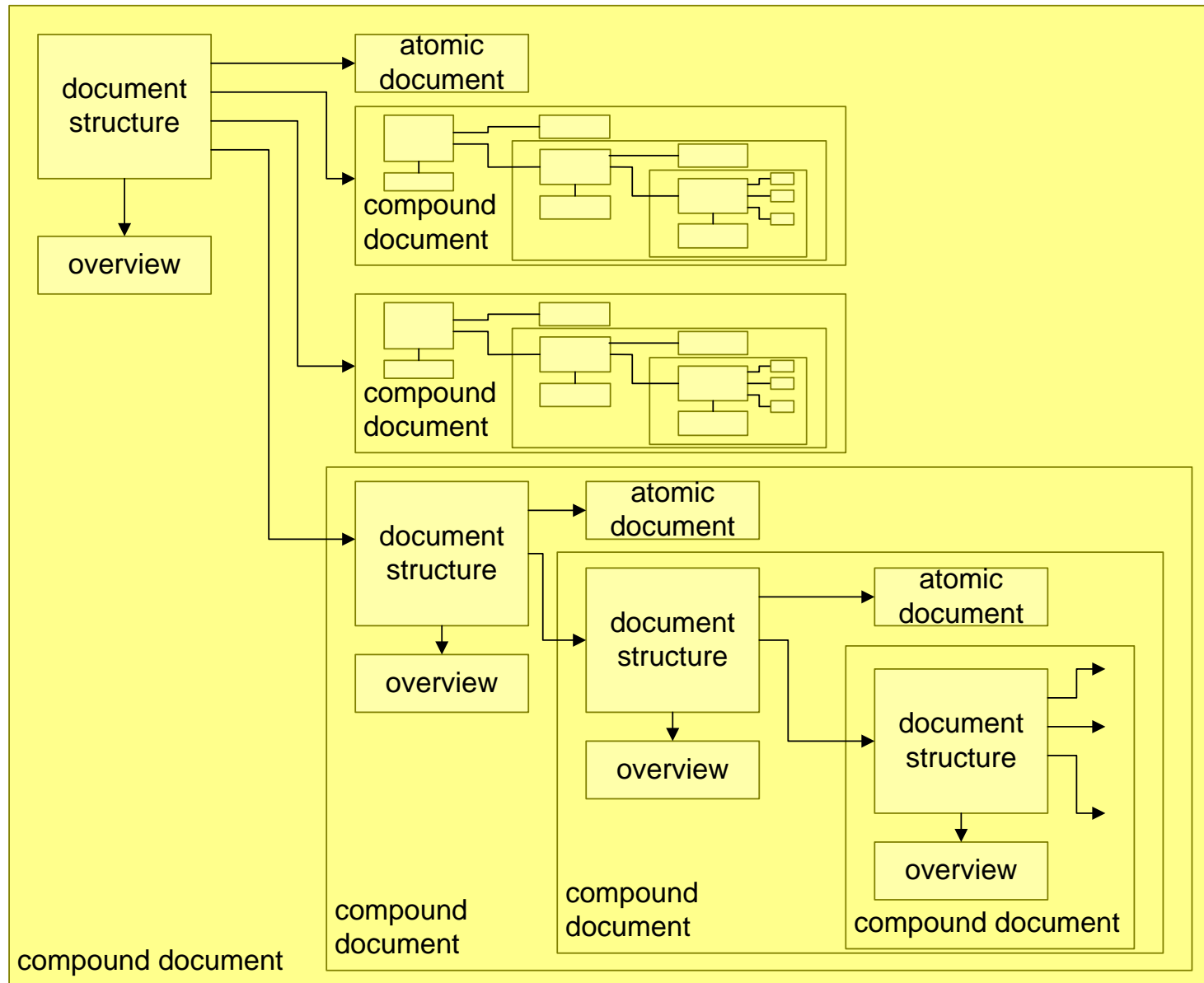

# Documentation Tree by Recursive Decomposition




# Payload: the Ratio between Content and Overhead


