
Typical Growth of a System Architect

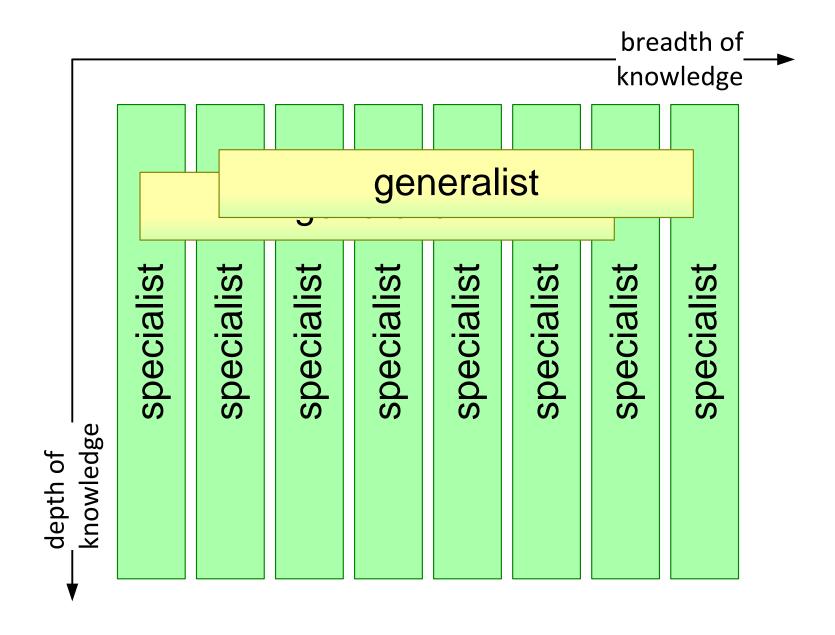


Generalist versus Specialist
